PERMITS

Retail/Commercial/Industrial Occupancy

Prior to signing a lease/purchase agreement, contact the Planning Department (440) 974-5740 to confirm that your business is permitted at the proposed location. If the zoning is suitable, discuss specific development standards with the Planning Department that may apply to your business (Occupancy Permit, Conditional Use Permits, parking requirements, Sign Regulations, Design Guidelines and Performance Standards).

Conditional Use Permits (CUP) – Required for outdoor dining, auto related businesses, drive-thru windows and other uses.

Parking – Number of spaces, lighting, and landscaping.

Signage – Size, number, color, and lighting of signs.

Building Permits

If you plan to make tenant improvements, renovations, or new construction, contact the Building Department to determine what plans need to be submitted and/or permits obtained at (440) 974-5785.

If your business intends to prepare and/or sell food, you will need a Health Department permit, contact them at (440) 350-2543 for more information.

Home-Based Business

Mentor Incentive Grant (MIG)

Multi-year performance grant based on a business's investment and the amount of new payroll taxes created. The more a business exceeds the initial payroll threshold, the more it benefits for the Mentor Incentive Grant.

A one-time grant for businesses that do not qualify for a MIG, but are investing in the City and expanding payroll. Grants between \$1,000 and \$10,000 are based on the amount of investment and new payroll taxes created.
